Make one, make two, make three, make four, spread the light of unity more and more! Use colour, use glitter, use paper and glue and show the world what the light of unity can do!

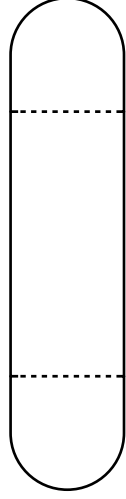
You will need:

- Glue stick

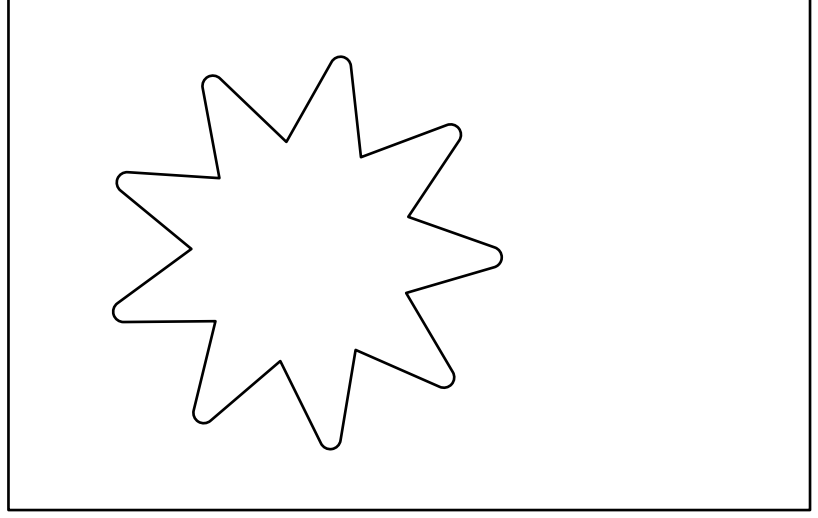
Optional (to add some sparkle):

- Glitter glue

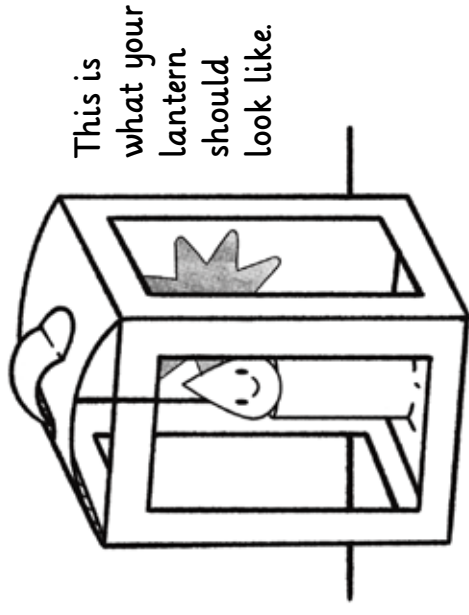
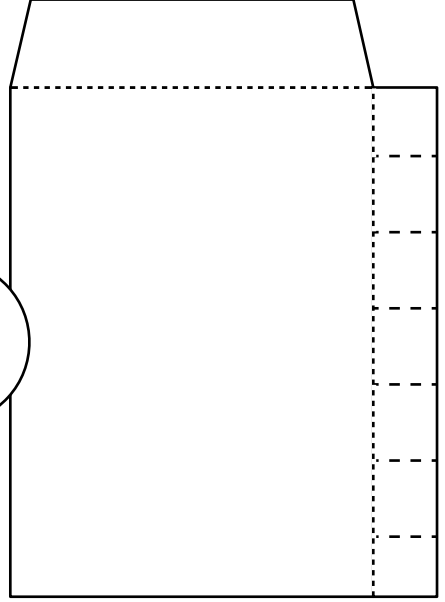
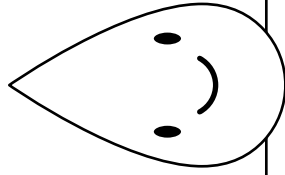

Candle Background



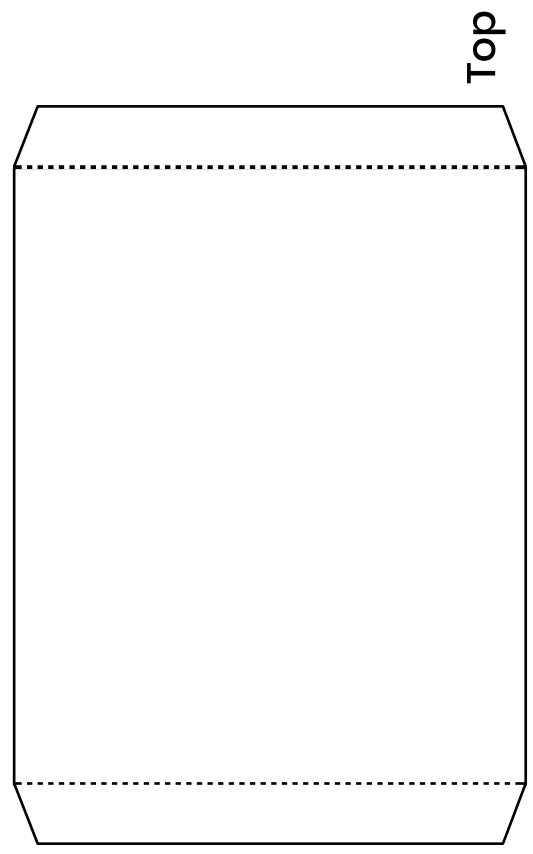
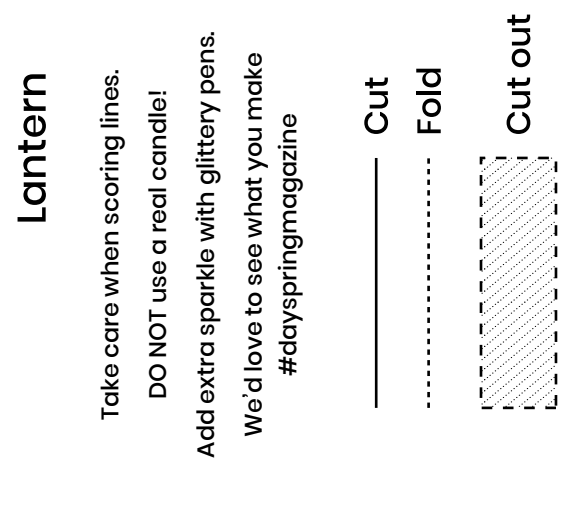
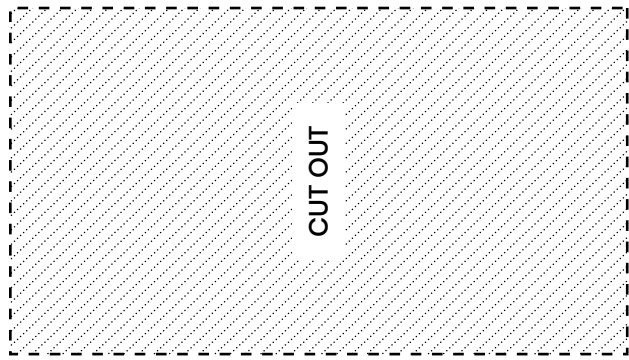
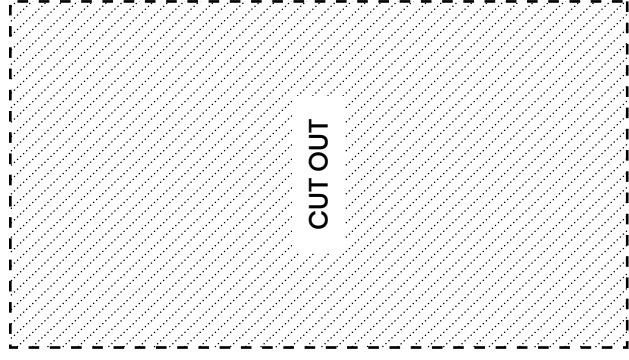
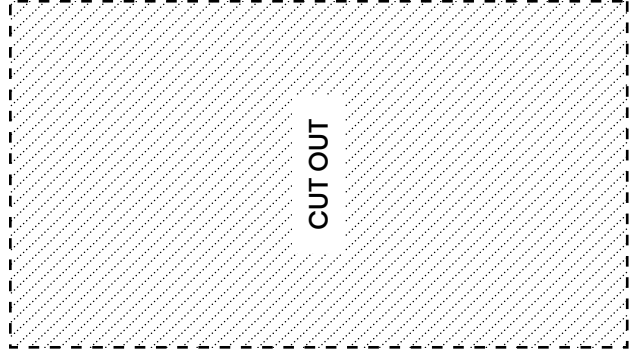
Candle



This is what your lantern should look like.

1. Carefully cut out the lantern, top, handle, candle and candle background.
2. Colour in both sides of the lantern, top and handle. Be as colourful as you like!
3. Colour in the candle and candle background.
4. Gently score the dotted lines and then fold them to establish a good crease.
5. Cut out the openings on the lantern.
6. Stick the candle background on the inside of the lantern on the only panel you haven't cut out.
7. Fold the lantern together and glue the tabs in place.
8. Glue the candle to the inside, bottom of the lantern.
9. Finally, fold the handle into a curve and glue to the top. Then fold the top into a curve and glue the tabs inside the lantern.

# BEETLE DRIVE

A fun group game for teams of 2-4 people.

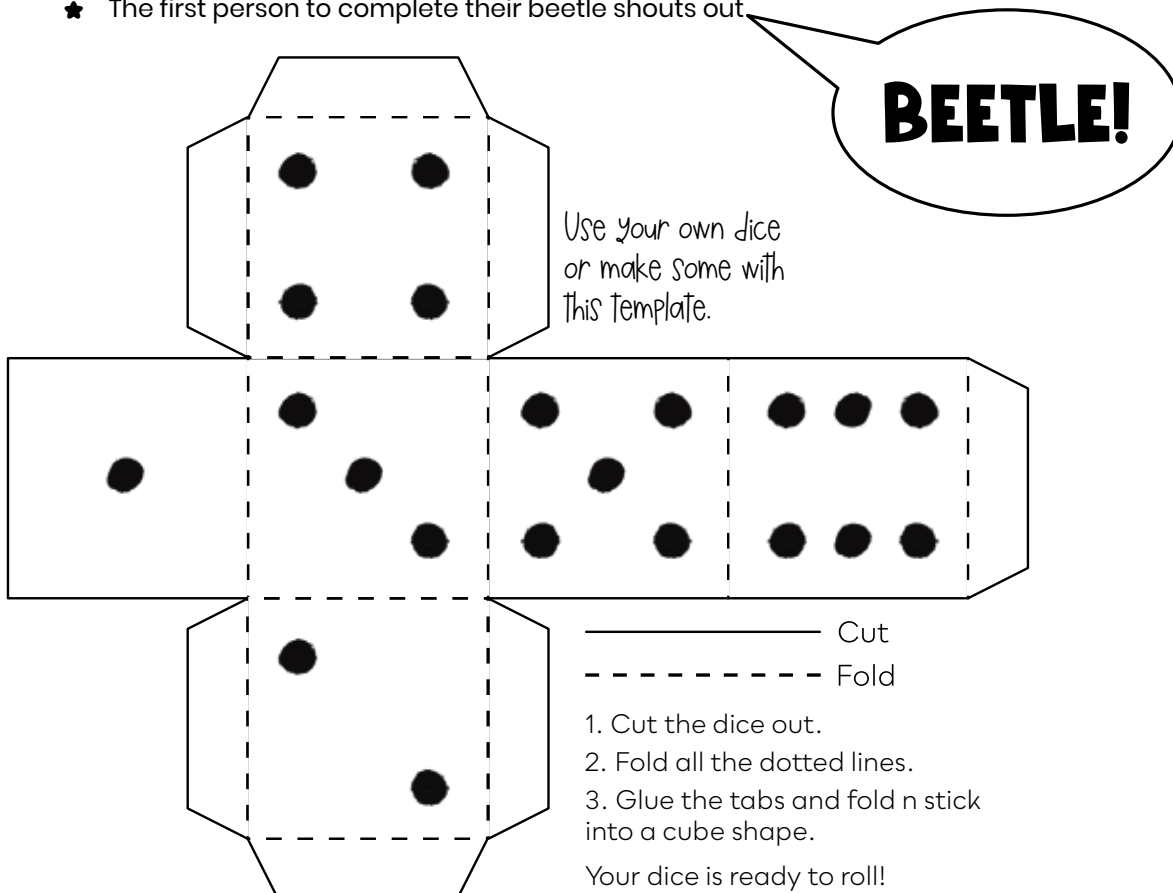
Beetle drive is a great game to play as a family or community. The game involves rolling dice to colour in (or draw body) parts of a beetle. The first player to complete their beetle wins! Teams play simultaneously until someone wins and more than one round can be played.

## YOU WILL NEED:

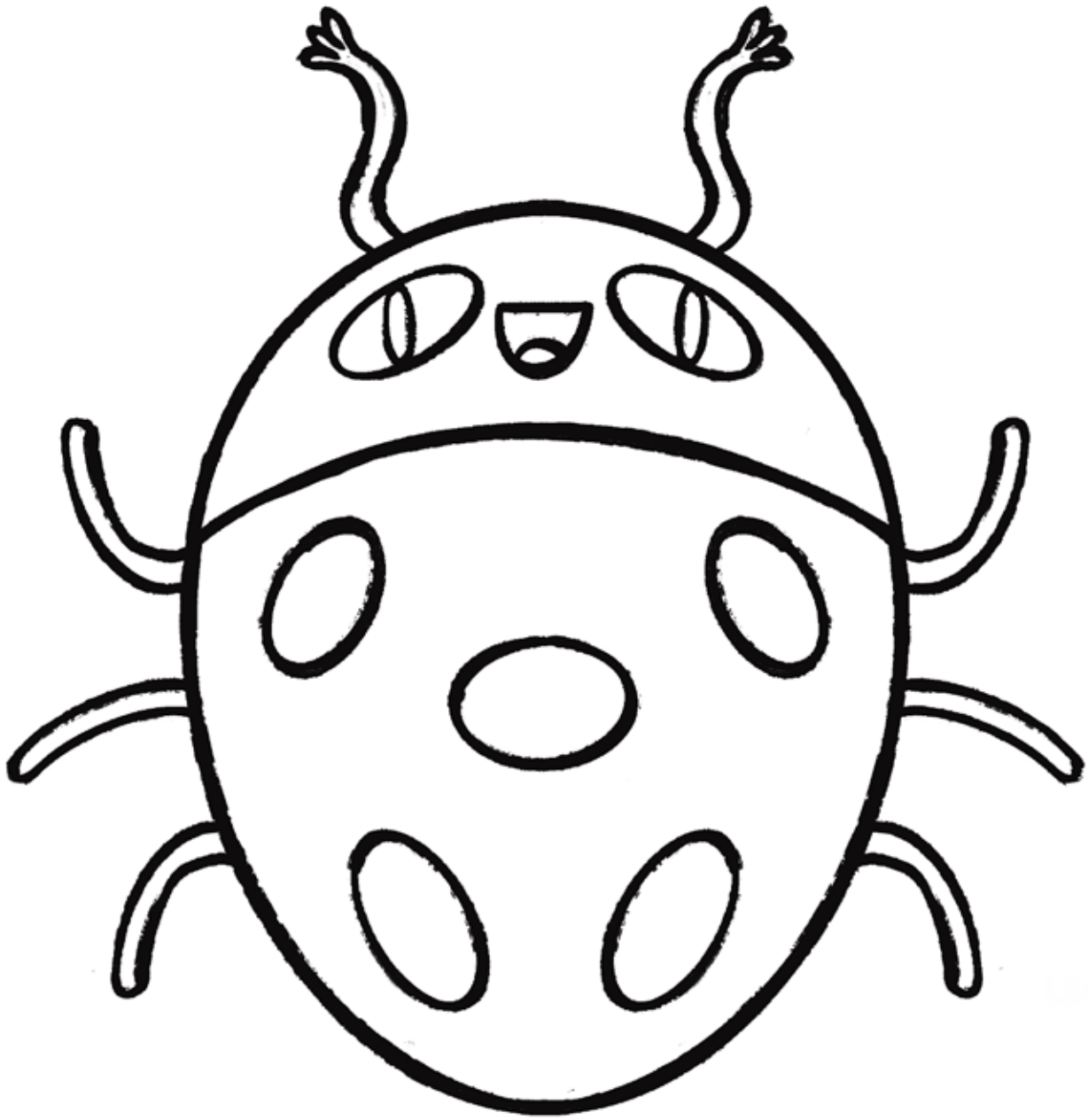
- ★ Teams of 2-4 players (teams must have the same number of players per team).
- ★ 1 dice per team (use your own or print the template below on card and make them).
- ★ 6 coloured pens or pencils (one per number on the dice for colouring in each beetle section).
- ★ 1 beetle sheet per person or you can give each player a plain sheet of paper and display the beetle sheet so everyone can see it and can draw each part of the beetle for themselves.

## HOW TO PLAY:

- ★ The youngest person on each team starts, so make sure they have the dice. Play goes round the team clockwise.
- ★ Someone counts "3-2-1-go!" and then all teams begin at the same time.
- ★ Each player takes it in turn to roll the dice once. If they roll a number that corresponds with a part of the beetle (see the beetle sheet) they either colour in or draw just one of that part, e.g. 1=1 eye, 2= antennae, 3=1 leg.
- ★ If you've already completed that part of the beetle you miss a go and hand the dice on to the next player.
- ★ Keep going until all of the beetle has been coloured in or drawn.
- ★ The first person to complete their beetle shouts out



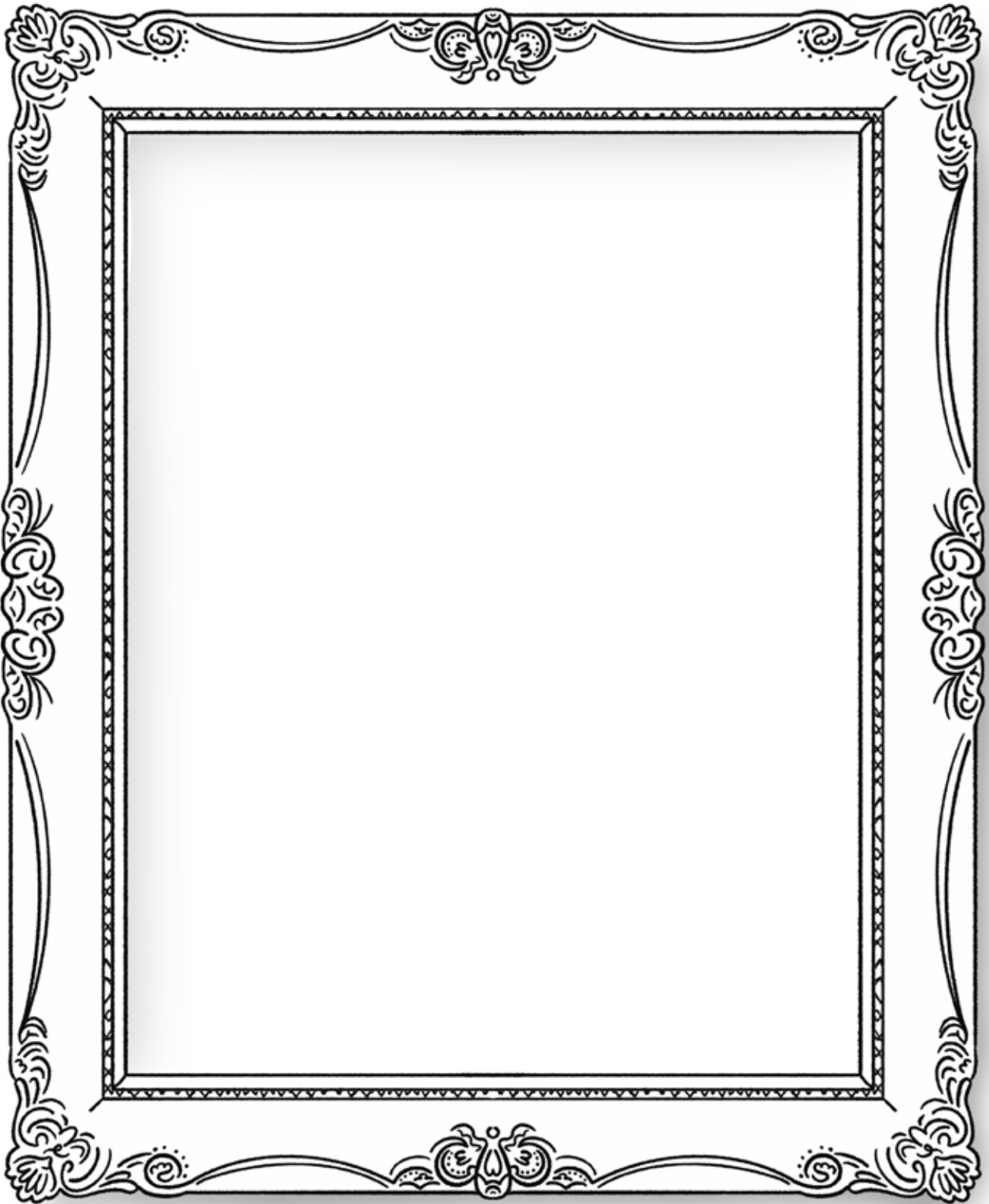
